

CHILD SEATS

Important:

The dinette table in the C-Medium, ROF C-Class, C-Large, and C-XLarge motorhomes may need to be lowered when infant seats are installed, meaning that no adults can sit in the dinette when travelling.

Children within weight range 9 kg to 18 kg should be kept rear-facing as long as possible.

No car seat required for children over 145 cm.

Motorhomes with Lap Belts Only

Please note that it is not illegal for children to sit in the dinette seats without booster seats, fastened with lap belts only. The purpose of the booster seat is to raise the seating level of the child in order to avoid the seat belt being at throat level, thus eliminating the danger of choking the child during brisk braking. In vehicles that are equipped with lap belts only, such as the C-XLarge motorhome, this risk is not present. Therefore, children of approx. 5 years of age or above, would be allowed to sit in the dinette seat fastened with a lap belt only. However, please note that it is ultimately up to the customer to decide. Fraserway RV Rentals will offer guidelines but will not make any decisions in this regard.

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
